The Michigan Flywheelers will host its annual antique engine and tractor show Thursday, Sept. 4th thru Sunday, Sept. 7th, at its show grounds located on 68th Street in South Haven, Michigan. Call 269-427-8443 for more information.

NO SET UPS BEFORE TUESDAY, SEPT. 2, 2008 AT 8:30 AM!

Rules

1) COST: **\$30.00** or more donation for a 23 x 25 **outdoor space** for the entire four days of the show. Corner spaces next to the main road will be **\$40.00** while center walkway spaces will be **\$35.00**. These corner spaces are limited and will be offered to the vendors that rented them last year first. Unreserved spaces are assigned on a first come basis.

You MUST set-up for all four days of the show if you rent a corner space next to the main road.

2) A **sales tax form MUST BE SIGNED** by all vendors. The vendor is responsible for any Michigan sales tax that may occur and filing the tax form.

3) There are **NO ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS** in the Flea Market!

4) No firearms, ammunition, fireworks, Michigan Flywheelers Museum logo items or food products like baked goods are to be sold in the flea market. Produce, including honey, is allowed.

5) **TWO WRISTBANDS PASSES** that allow entrance to the show, will be given out per vendor (not per space). Additional bands for helpers will be available from the manager at \$5.00 per band. These are good for the entire four days of the show. You **MUST wear a wristband** or pay to enter the show.

6) Flea Market manager reserves the right to return set-up fees and remove vendors who do not cooperate with the rules or are to be determined not to be in the best interest of the show.

7) Persons renting the space are responsible for clean up and keeping it neat during the show.

8) A separate **antique iron area** for sellers will be available as well as a special area consisting of just **craft** vendors. Please ask for these rows if you would like to be in them. You must sell **100 PERCENT** Antique Iron or 100 % crafts to be in these rows.

9) **Quiet Time** is held nightly from midnight to 7 am. This means no running generators or barking dogs etc.

10). **NO REFUNDS** will be given.

11. **CAMPING & VEHICLES: Vendors are allowed to camp on their spaces as well as park vehicles on their lots. If you need to camp in our camping area, camping fees will apply. If you have no room for vehicles on your lot, then we ask that you please park them in the parking lot.**

You will receive confirmation of your preregistration by postcard no later than August 1st.
