

2010 MFM Flea Market Contract

The Michigan Flywheelers Museum will host its annual Antique Engine and Tractor Show Thursday, Sept. 9 - Sunday, Sept. 12, 2010, at the museum which is located on 68th Street in South Haven.

SET-UP STARTS TUESDAY, SEPT. 7, 2010 AT 8:30 AM!

No vendor set-ups between 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

Please plan accordingly.

PRE-REGISTRATION FEES

(BEFORE July 1, 2010)

- 23 x 25 space: **\$35.00**
- 23 x 25 Center walkway spaces - **\$40.00**
- 23 x 25 Corner spaces next to the main road- **\$45.00**

LATE-REGISTRATION FEES

(AFTER July 1, 2010)

- 23 x 25 space: **\$40.00**
- 23 x 25 Center walkway spaces - **\$45.00**
- 23 x 25 Corner spaces next to the main road- **\$50.00**

Vendors that rented lots last year have until July 1, 2010 to rent the same lots. After that date, lots are rented on a first come basis. **All prices are good for the entire four days of the show. You MUST set-up for the entire show if you rent a corner space.** All spaces are outdoors. There are no electrical hookups. Water is available. Registration fees will be determined by postmark on envelope.

- A **sales tax form MUST BE SIGNED** by all vendors. The vendor is responsible for any Michigan sales tax that may occur and filing the tax form.
 - No firearms, ammunition, fireworks, Michigan Flywheelers Museum logo items or food products like baked goods are to be sold in the flea market. Produce, including honey, is allowed.
 - **TWO WRISTBANDS PASSES** will be given out per vendor (not per space). Additional bands for helpers will be available from the manager at \$5.00 per band. These are good for the entire four days of the show. You **MUST wear a wristband** or pay to enter the show.
 - Flea Market manager reserves the right to remove vendors who do not cooperate with the rules or are to be determined not to be in the best interest of the show. **NO REFUNDS** will be given.
 - Persons renting the space are responsible for clean up and keeping it neat during the show.
 - A separate **antique iron area** for sellers will be available as well as a special area for **arts & crafts** vendors. Please ask for these rows if you would like to be in them. You must sell **100% Antique Iron** or **100% Crafts** to be in these rows.
 - **QUIET TIME** is held nightly from midnight to 7 am. This means no running generators or barking dogs etc.
 - **CAMPING & VEHICLES:** Vendors are allowed to camp on their spaces if there is room. If you need to camp in our camping area, camping fees will apply. Vehicle traffic in the Flea Market is prohibited from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday. You can park a vehicle on your lot, but **please make sure you are in the show by 9 a.m. or you will have to park in the visitor's lot.**
- FLEA MARKET OPERATING HOURS: 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Thursday-Saturday; 9 a.m. - 2 p.m. Sunday.**
